Racing Victoria is the body responsible for and carries out the functions of: determining and issuing occupational licences authorising persons to participate in the Victorian thoroughbred racing industry ("Licensed Persons"); supervising Licensed Persons; administering and promoting racing; and such other functions as may be described in its privacy policy published on its website from time to time ("Privacy Policy"). In the course of performing its functions, Racing Victoria may seek personal information from you for the purposes of:

- making determinations in relation to your licence application, renewal or continuance;
- meeting supervisory responsibilities in relation to you as a Licensed Person;
- promoting or protecting the integrity of the thoroughbred racing code and ensuring compliance with the Rules of Racing;

- any other function or activity described in the Privacy Policy.




INDUSTRY MANDATORY TRAINING

All *new* applicants for the grant of a Riders Agent licence must complete skills training as nominated by the Board of Racing Victoria. **Note; any “existing” applicant will not be required to complete this training.**

An outline of the specific nationally accredited training units required for the riders agent category of licence, is as follows:

RIDERS AGENTS:

1. Comply with the Rules of Racing; and
2. Communicate in the Workplace.

Following is some frequently asked questions relating to the completion of this training. If you have any queries, do not hesitate to contact your nearest TAFE training provider:

1. What if I already have the skills and experience, or I have already completed some training in the past?

You will still be required to complete the mandatory training. However, the process does allow for a “fast track” option, called *Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)*. Simply notify the TAFE provider that you believe you have the necessary skills and experience, or have previously completed training. The TAFE provider will then take your previous training or experience into consideration.

Completing this training provides you with formal recognition for your level of experience gained over the years. It can also provide you with a pathway to further studies within the equine industry should you wish to experience other aspects of the industry.

2. What is the cost of completing the training?

The cost of training can vary depending on whether you are eligible for Government funding, however it depends on what level of education/qualification you already have – please ensure you discuss this with your TAFE provider.

Generally, the cost of training will range from \$150 to \$300.
